

WHAT IS BENCHMARKING?

- Benchmarking is the practice of comparing performance metrics to industry standards and best practices from other companies.
- Understanding how other school's operate can help inform how you set your goals, your schools areas of strength and growth, and where to prioritize your team's time.
- DASL is the financial and operational benchmarking tool for Jewish day schools & yeshivas.



WHAT CAN BENCHMARKING DO FOR YOU?

Types of questions benchmarking data can answer

- Is my school's attrition rate normal?
- How does our school's tuition compare to similar schools in similar cities?
- What percentage of budget do other schools spend on staff salaries?
- What percent of budget do other schools receive in net tuition?
- How does our fundraising goal compare to similar schools?
- School level enrollment trends, are other similar schools experiencing the same thing?



REAL SCHOOL EXAMPLES

- School A interested in teacher recruitment and retention.
- School B interested hiring new development professional.
- School C is our attrition rate high or low compared to our peer schools?
- School D What percent of our annual campaign should come from current parents and trustees?



WHAT IS DASL?

Data and Analysis for School Leadership (DASL)

• Data collection & reporting tool developed by the National Association for Independent schools (aka NAIS).

DASL

- Create and access custom benchmarking reports to compare your schools' figures to national or regional figures, or to the customized comparison group of schools that you choose.
- Longitudinal analysis
- 1700+ Independent schools
- 100+ Jewish day schools and yeshivas





- Gives school leaders access to a tool that can help you make strategic financial, enrollment and fundraising decisions.
- Ability to build to custom benchmarking reports with individual school, communal, and field wide comparisons.
- Can be used as a place to store you school's key metrics over time.
- Centralized data collection will allow current DASL users to save time.

Average 67% Median 70%




REPORTING: DASHBOARDS FOR NETWORK SCHOOLS

DASL Data Foundation: June through October 2022

- Decide how your team will enter data
 - Online or excel/google sheets
 - One person collects the data from various sources vs different people on the team are responsible for specific sections.
- School user access levels
- Activate
- Enter data
- Review, approve and submit data

DASL Financial Operations June through November 2022

- Enter data
- Review, approve and submit data






