SBA Loans Available to Nonprofits Through COVID-19 Federal Aid Program

The massive \$2 trillion aid package being approved this week by the US government includes a pool of \$350 billion in funding available through the Small Business Administration for businesses and nonprofit organizations, to enable them to sustain employment through the crisis.

While the legislative details are still being hammered out, The Jewish Federations of North America is working to assemble resources to help all Jewish nonprofit organizations access this help.

While there are some exclusions in the bill, <u>most</u> Jewish nonprofit organizations — Federations, JCCs, synagogues, schools, human service organizations, Hillels, youth organizations, engagement organizations and others — can derive benefit from this program to help you through the critical months ahead and preserve your organization.
