TOP 10 WAYS FOR COMMUNITIES TO SAY THANK YOU TO JEWISH DAY SCHOOL EDUCATORS

- 1. **Tell them how you feel:** Send heartfelt, personal notes or video messages directly to teachers from parents and students (current and former). Notes can also be made into a book, gift box, or another meaningful collection.
- 2. **Give them an enjoyable experience:** Special distanced, virtual or outdoor events or gatherings for teachers (and their families!), like concerts, movie nights, or game nights.
- Make their classrooms or home teaching areas extra special: Give them books, gift certificates, or start fundraising campaigns for their classroom wish lists and libraries.
- 4. **Take the burden of meals off their plate:** Give them gift certificates for takeout or dine in meals for the whole family or provide catered shabbat meals for them.
- 5. **Show the love:** Decorate posters or messages to hang in their classrooms, outside their houses, or even chalk on their driveways!
- 6. **Get creative:** Organize a carwash for all staff—make them (and their cars!) feel shiny and new inside and out.
- 7. **Go social:** Build a social media campaign and have community leaders, rabbis, and families flood social media with messages for teachers.
